
The Mariners of PGI have a new additional communications app. Please go to your app store and download "Stack Team App.



Team App is a FREE and secure platform enabling any club to create their own customizable communication application. It will run on either a computer or smart phone. It is designed to improve member communication, activity scheduling, and a store to sell club clothing and associated items along with a method of on-line payments within the organization. Stack Team is an all-in-one team or club management tool allowing you to instantly send SMS alerts & messages to members or groups within the club. With this app, we can quickly schedule and manage events, post pictures, and stay connected with the club with instant posts and comments and know who will be at events with RSVP.

Joining Stack TeamApp



The following is from President John Walsh:

The PG/CHBA will have at least three openings for board positions for 2024. Our organization is vital to recreational boating and the marine industry in Southwest Florida. We have built strong relationships with The City and The County and through our relationship with The Southwest Florida Marine Industry Association we have a lobbying presence in Tallahassee. This organization has been involved in most of the critical decisions in this area since it was formed after Hurricane Charlie: Buckley's Pass; Weather Stations on the harbor; Securing funding for the police department, through MAC grants, a new boats and derelict boat removal; Purchasing; "Clear Head" -the pump out boat-through a MAC grant; authoring the Waterfront Development Plan contained in the City Master Plan; The "Dock Match Program"; and many many more projects over the past 18 years.

I have been President of The Boaters Alliance for five (5) of the last six years and on the board for six years. While I have thoroughly enjoyed serving the boating community It is time for new blood and new energy for this vital organization. Your delegate to The Boaters Alliance or the alternate for your organization can serve on the board.

If qualified and willing members do not step up I fear for the organization.


It's fall... at least that's what the calendar says.
