Important Letter from President John Walsh of the Boater's Alliance:

The board of The Boaters Alliance voted to dissolve the Punta Gorda/Charlotte Harbor Boater's Alliance because only one person (very reluctantly) stepped forward to serve on the board in 2024 to fill one of the needed positions. Bob Hickey (past president), Paula Hickey (treasurer), Diane Welsh (secretary), and I (President) will not be serving on the board next year. Stephen Kapin (board

member) has informed the board that he will be leaving the board and the area sometime in 2024. Gene Pawlowski (vice-president) is willing to continue to serve on the board. Organizations must have solid leadership and responsible individuals to manage its affairs. Without a strong board the Boaters Alliance cannot be effective or continue to operate.

The Boater's Alliance has been an important and vital organization for boating for the past 20 years. It is unfortunate that PG/CHBA may not continue to serve our city and county in the future.

# If volunteers step forward to fill the board positions needed the dissolution can be avoided. If you would like to volunteer you can contact me or any of our board members. This must be done quickly due to the requirement to publish a slate of officers 30 days prior to elections.

There will be a vote on the fate of The Boaters Alliance at the January meeting (At the Punta Gorda Isles Civic Association – 2001 Shreve St., Punta Gorda, 9:00 am January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024).

Joan Erickson will be coming on board and she is looking forward to her new role and working with all of you.


