So, get ready for some cooler weather and nice days for cruising



Starlink Service Plans

Starlink, SpaceX's satellite internet service, offers connectivity for boaters, allowing them to stay connected even while out on the water. Here are the current Starlink plans tailored for maritime use:

- Boats Service Plans:
- Consumer Plan (Best for Coastal and Inland Waterways):
 - Monthly Cost: Starting at \$165
 - Hardware Cost: \$299
 - Data Allowance: Unlimited Roam Data
 - Ideal Use: Suitable for consumers along the coast and on inland waterways. It provides high-speed internet with download speeds ranging from 40 to 220+ Mbps and upload speeds of 8 to 25+ Mbps. This plan is great for general internet usage while boating 1.
- Mobile Priority 50GB Plan (Best for Ocean Navigation):
 - Monthly Cost: \$250
 - Data Allowance: Unlimited Mobile Data inland
 - Ideal Use: Designed for navigation or weather monitoring on the ocean. It prioritizes critical data needs for safety and navigation¹.
- Mobile Priority 1TB Plan (Best for Streaming and Gaming):
 - Monthly Cost: \$1,000
 - Data Allowance: Unlimited Mobile Data inland
 - Ideal Use: Perfect for streaming movies, video calls, and gaming while out on the ocean. It provides ample data for entertainment and communication needs¹.
- 2. Starlink Maritime Plans (Updated as of April 2023):
 - 50 GB Priority Access Plan:
 - Monthly Cost: \$250
 - Data Allowance: 50 GB of priority access at sea.
 - 1 TB Plan:
 - Monthly Cost: \$1,000
 - **Data Allowance**: 1 TB of data for high-speed internet usage while at sea².

Keep in mind that Starlink's hardware is designed to withstand extreme conditions at sea, including cold, heat, heavy rain, and hurricane winds. You can integrate Starlink with your onboard networks via direct Ethernet connection or use the included Wi-Fi router. Plus, you have the flexibility to pause and un-pause the service as needed 1.

If you're interested, you can try Starlink for 30 days, and if you're not satisfied, they offer a full refund. So, whether you're navigating coastal waters or venturing into the open ocean, Starlink aims to keep you connected with reliable internet service¹.

Feel free to explore these options and choose the one that best fits your boating needs!
